Just Lent 6 PEACE

This week is the final week of the Just Lent series and the theme is **PEACE.** The Palm Sunday liturgy Mark 11: 1-10 always begins with a joyful celebration acclaiming Jesus with Hosannas. In every parish we recall this as we wave our branches high.

These branches, from the tree of the Olive signified peace and Jesus came into the gates of Jerusalem as a messenger of peace.

We know that the same crowds who shouted 'Hosanna' were quick to change and, in the Gospel, are shouting 'Crucify him!

This year we too are called to listen like Jesus to the voices in our world where violence is alive and bring to this the only remedy for war; the peace of Christ.
