# Welcome Pope Francis!

We welcome Pope Francis on his visit to our city this weekend. His warm greeting on Tuesday at the opening event in the World Meeting of Families invited our prayers for him. We pray too for the success of his visit to us at such a critical time for the Church in Ireland and for the success of this international gathering with focus on the significance of family life.

At 81 years of age his pastoral schedule is immense. Already this year he has gone to Chile and Peru in March, to Geneva and its World Council of Churches in June and later in September he'll visit Lithuania, Estonia and Latvia. In October (3<sup>rd</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>), the Synod of Bishops in Rome will address the issue of 'young people, the faith and vocational discernment'.

We are grateful for his coming to us at a time of brokenness in the light of scandals that have shocked us all, a time of significant crisis of faith for many and of challenging living out of the vision of faith at a time of increasing secular influence.

# **Pakistani Pilgrims**

Our planned celebration with Pakistani pilgrims (250 registered) scheduled for Friday evening this week (August 24<sup>th</sup>) was necessarily cancelled when it transpired on Tuesday that visas had been granted to only a handful of pilgrims. We thank our parishioners who kindly offered their help to welcome and celebrate with them.

We had felt honoured when chosen to host pilgrims from a country where Christians have suffered much in recent years under a wave of fundamentalist terror groups. We hold them in our thoughts and prayers, aware that whatever prompted this visa refusal, there were doubtless genuine pilgrims among them, disappointed by the visa refusal.
