A Timely Reminder?

At the beginning of a new Financial Year in the Parish it may be a timely exercise to check if your traceable donations to the Parish exceed €250 a year (it's the equivalent of €21 per month).

It could be composed of the summation of Christmas and Easter Dues along with such monthly / annual donations as would render the cumulative amount to be $\[mathebox{0.6}\]$ or greater. The Charities Act meets a $\[mathebox{0.6}\]$ donation with a 31% rebate in benefit of the Charity. It means in effect that your $\[mathebox{0.6}\]$ increases to a total donation of $\[mathebox{0.6}\]$ What a pity if someone donates $\[mathebox{0.6}\]$ Worth checking!
