# In this time of health crisis ...

- All are dispensed from the obligation to physically attend Sunday Mass.
- The health authority's limit of 100 people attending such gatherings as our Mass must be upheld. Mass will be celebrated under that condition. Parishioners are advised that they can link with every celebration of Mass in our parish through webcam (google 'Star of the Sea Parish, Sandymount' or go directly to <a href="www.stmarysstaroftheseasandymount.com">www.stmarysstaroftheseasandymount.com</a>) Go to the CAM arrow to access transmission at the usual Mass times.
- We will greatly appreciate your understanding and help in ensuring that no more than 100 people are in attendance at a church gathering. We regret the necessary inconvenience to some as a result.
- In church, people should be seated at a physical distance from each other. A distance of at least a metre is to be observed.
- Funerals will be celebrated but limited to close relatives or friends with at most 100 people inside the church. Larger gatherings of up to 500 could take place outside after Mass or at a graveyard. To ensure that no more than 100 people are in the church please observe that there is seating for 3 in the centre aisle seats with every second seat empty (see white label to confirm which seat is used) and

likewise 2 per seat in the 2 side aisles. The seats at Our Lady's altar are not to be used.

- Similarly Church Weddings and Baptisms can take place on condition that attendance does not exceed 100 people inside the church.
- It is not permitted to pass baskets or collection bags from person to person. The first (Common Fund) and second (Share) collections will be taken at the church entrance and closely monitored there. There is also an on-line payment facility for the Common Fund and Share collections on the front page of the Dublin diocesan website. Click on 'Donate' if you wish to pursue this.
- The church will be open at the usual hours to facilitate your coming to pray. It is important that we pray for each other during this testing time. Remember those who are ill and pray for the frontline health workers.

Any one of us could unwittingly be a carrier. Use the hand sanitizer and wash hands as directed frequently. Watch out for the elderly and those most vulnerable to the threat of the virus. We all must play our part.

#### **Confirmation Celebrations**

We warmly congratulate the 68 young people who were confirmed this week. They were confirmed by Fr. Donal Roche, our new Episcopal Vicar for the area of the diocese from Ringsend to Arklow. Our thanks to all involved – parents, teachers, sacristans, music ministers and the young people – both those confirmed and those who sang beautifully.

It was the last large gathering in our church for the foreseeable future. It was announced just after our ceremony that no further Confirmation celebrations will be held while the current public health crisis persists.
