Another Angle on today's Gospel: Living Authentically

Countless faiths have pondered on the idea of who can be saved? What about those who never heard of the Gospel? Are we on the right side? And all this talk of a narrow door is a bit unnerving, is it not?

What matters is to act, to do courageously all that lies in our power to enter. Live authentically; it doesn't matter if what you do is noticed or not. Ultimately you have to face yourself in the mirror. You have brains in your head and feet in your shoes. You can steer yourself any direction you choose. As schools return this week, a little story from the East may help. An elderly sage was educating his young disciples about life. He tells of a dreadful battle between two lions that goes on in every person. One lion is wicked: he is fear, rage, jealousy, sadness, greed, pride, self-pity, shame, hatred, weakness, lies, rivalry and superiority. The other lion is good: he is happiness, harmony, love, trust, sharing, peace. modesty, gentleness, compassion, friendship, understanding, charity, truth, kindness and loyalty. He was asked: 'Which lion will win?' The answer: 'The one you feed the most.' Which of the two lions within you do you make the strongest?

The Crosscare Annual Collection for **Community, Homeless and Youth services** will take place in churches throughout the Dublin Diocese on next weekend Sat 31st August and Sun 1st September 2019.
