Archbishop Diarmuid Martin in a message this Wednesday highlights

- The fundamental message is that people should stay at home if at all possible.
- Outdoor events are limited to gatherings of 4.
- Churches are open for private prayer provided that there is at all times strict adherence to physical distancing (2 meters is more than 6ft). Vulnerable people are not encouraged to leave their homes.
- Sensitivity and prudence is called for in the event of funerals – both in respect to numbers and ritual. Particular HSE guidelines apply in the event of a person dying of the corona virus.
- Two strong church traditions are counselled at this time –
 - (1) Spiritual Communion, when one doesn’t receive Communion in a celebration of Mass as in this time of danger.
 - (2) In the event of difficulty in accessing Confession, making an act of perfect contrition with the desire to receive the sacrament of reconciliation is sufficient for the forgiveness of all sins even mortal sins

Holy Week ceremonies

With the churches closed until mid April at the earliest, the liturgical celebration this Holy Week and Easter will be very different. We will endeavour to bring you celebrations on the web cam - details to follow. Next Sunday will be Palm Sunday.

At the 10.30am Mass next Sunday we hope again to link up with the children and parents in the First Communion classes. Palm Sunday was to be our next 'Do this in Memory' Mass. Meanwhile the children could work on pages 56 to 59 of the Thumbs book and parents might share with them pages 20 to 23 of Thumbs. Grapevine 6 and Grapevine 7 will be held in safe keeping until the children come back to school.

In this time of crisis in the threat of the corona virus

- Public Mass celebrations have ceased until mid April when the situation will be reviewed.
- Mass will be celebrated daily, Mon to Sat on the parish webcam at 10.00am. (Google 'Star of the Sea, Sandymount', then scroll down to MCN streaming, enter and hit CAM arrow).
- RTE NEWS NOW will broadcast daily Mass at 10.30am.
- This coming weekend March 28th / 29th we will celebrate Mass on the parish webcam on Saturday at 6.00pm and Sunday at 10.30am.
