The Date of Easter

At the Council of Nicaea in 325, the date for Easter was fixed as the 'first Sunday after the first full moon after the Spring equinox.' On that calculation, the feast of Easter this year falls on 21st April 2019.

Eastern Christians calculate the date of Easter according to the Julian Calendar, the Calendar in general use before the Gregorian reform of 1582. One of the reforms introduced by Pope Gregory was the removal of 10 days from the Calendar and this discrepancy between the Julian and Gregorian Calendars results often in a difference in the date of Easter in East and West as they follow the two Calendars. This happens this year, 2019, when the date of Easter for Eastern Christians is one week later on Sunday 28th April.

In the Jewish calendar, Passover is celebrated this year on 20th April, beginning at sundown the previous evening (14 Nisan 5779) and continuing for seven days.

The visit of the football team from Georgia last week reminded me of Tom. Engaged as a consultant to Georgia's national education examinations system, the date proposed coincided with our Holy Week. Anxious to uphold his participation in the Holy Week ceremonies, Tom requested a postponement to the following week and it was duly granted. It emerged that the new date now coincided with the Eastern church's Holy Week in Georgia! He celebrated Easter twice that year and when the work was completed, the Sunday Eucharist lasted three hours.

Baptisms in April

Baptisms will be on 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month as a general rule. In April there will not be a celebration on the 3rd Sunday, which is Easter Day. In April the sacrament will be celebrated on April 7th, at the Easter Vigil on the night of April 20th and on April 28th.
